### A. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Corporate Information: INTELLECT BUILDCON PRIVATE LIMITED (the 'Company') is a Private limited company domiciled in India, incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956. The Company is engaged in trading activity.

- I. For all periods, up to and including the year ended 31st March 2017, the Company prepared its financial statements in accordance with accounting standard notified under section 133 of Companies Act 2013 read with paragraph 7 of the Companies (Accounts ) Rules 2014. Accordingly, financial statement for the year ended 31st March 2017 and opening Balance Sheet as at 1st April 2016 (Transition Date ) had been restated in accordance with Ind-AS for comparative information purpose in preparation and of the Company's first Ind-AS compliant financial statements.

- III. Basis of Measurement: These financial statements have been prepared on a historical cost basis, Historical cost is generally based on the fair value of the consideration given in exchange for the goods and services
- IV. Use of Estimates and Judgment: The preparation of financial statements in conformity with Ind AS requires Management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions, that affect the application of accounting policies and the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income, expenses and disclosures of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of these financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses for the years presented. Historical Cost includes the acquisition cost or the cost of construction, including duties and taxes (other than those refundable), expenses directly related to the acquisition of assets and making them operational for their intended use.
Depreciation is provided prorate basis on straight line method at the rates determined based on estimated useful lives of tangible assets where

VII. Intangible Asset: Intangible assets purchased are measured at cost as of the date of acquisition less accumulated amortization and accumulated impairment, if any Amortization is recognized on a straight-line basis over their estimated useful lives. prospective basis.
VIII. Foreign Currency Transactions and Translations:
